

RE: Microplastics in sachet tea bags

To Whom it may concern,

A recent study that indicates some of our competitors' premium sachet teabags made from petrochemical-derived PET plastic or nylon can leave billions of microplastic particles in their tea during the steeping process.

Teatulia pyramid teabags are made from plant starch, not any of the materials examined in the recent study. Further, Teatulia's manufacturing process does not use any adhesives to seal the tea bags; they are sealed ultrasonically which is faster and cleaner.

This results in a product that is free of any petrochemical-derived materials that are causing alarm. The teabags Teatulia uses are upheld by food safety standards of the FDA, EU and Japan.
